



Candella's Farm and Greenhouses is a multi-generational family farm located in Marcy, NY. Visitors can find an abundance of ornamental and vegetable plants for home or garden. Candella's also offers a 10-week subscription harvest box annually, a great way to get fresh produce from a farm right here in Oneida County. In the summer, guests can find a bountiful crop of U-pick strawberries, blueberries, and raspberries. Pre-picked fruits are available as well, fresh-picked daily.

Candella's Greenhouse is open from May to December, Mon through Fri 9am to 6pm, Sat 9am to 5pm, and Sun 9am to 4pm. U-pick hours vary seasonally, check website and social media for up-to-date information.



The mill is open from mid-August to Thanksgiving for cider season, Monday through Saturday from 10am to 6pm, and Sundays 10am to 5pm. Keep a lookout on their social media during the off-season for pop-up events.

Parker F. Scripture Botanical Gardens






