Performers shall perform only if registered and accepted for performance by the market manager.

Performances shall be live and perform from 10am-11:30 am and 11:45-1pm, unless determined otherwise by the market manager.

Performers may offer for sale their own recordings/merchandise.

Performers may receive contributions in a receptacle such as an open instrument case, box or hat but not by actively asking for tips or passing around the receptacle.

Performers are responsible for providing their own PA system.

The market will provide power to the performance location. Amplification shall be allowed and subject to a level determined by market manager to not disrupt the primary purpose of the market.

Performances which involve harassing market shoppers, panhandling, shouting, disseminating propaganda or other potentially abusive or disruptive behavior will not be permitted.

Performers may be photographed by the market and used for promotional purposes for buskers in the future.

Return performances shall be at the discretion of the market manager.

Oneida County Public Market Operating Protocol and Attestation for Vendors and Employees 2026-2027

All vendors and employees must sign acknowledging that you have read, understood, and agree to abide by this protocol to help mitigate the spread of illnesses.

I will refrain from coming to the Oneida County Public Market if any of the following apply:

I am experiencing symptoms associated with illness.

Symptoms may include but are not limited to:

- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fever
- chills
- muscle pain
- new loss of taste or smell
- sore throat and headache

If I have symptoms, I agree to follow CDC hand hygiene guidelines to prevent the spread of illness:

- I will wash my hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing my nose, coughing, or sneezing; and /or going to the bathroom;
- If soap and water are not readily available, I will use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol to cover the surfaces of my hands;
- I will avoid touching my eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands;
- I will agree to follow local Department of Health guidelines related to public health concerns and any illness issues;
- I will keep my booth/personal work area cleaned and disinfected
